History of Track Cycling

The first recorded cycling competition was a road race held in Paris in 1868. The three different disciplines (road, track and mountain bike) held today have evolved mainly because of technological developments relating to bicycles.

England and the United States were active in pioneering cycling and dominated the sport in the early years. With the increased popularity of the sport, especially in Europe, cycling success on the track is now more widespread among countries.

The world's first bike race for women is said to have taken place in the Sydney suburb of Ashfield in 1888.

Track Cycling today

In a sport where every one-hundredth of a second counts, optimum wind resistance and aerodynamics have become a premium. Track riders now wear skin suits, made of polyester-like material and aerodynamic helmets to assist in their pursuit of record times. Track bicycles have only one gear and no brakes. The gear size is set up according to the event being contested and the riding style of the cyclist. The degree of technical and strategic skill required in each of the track events often results in cyclists specialising in either the sprint or endurance disciplines.

Track Cycling at the Olympic Games

Track events have been contested at the Olympic Games since Athens in 1896, when the one-lap sprint, the 2000m, 10 000m and a 12-hour track race featured on the Olympic program. The first women's track cycling event was held at the 1988 Seoul Olympic Games, when the women's sprint was added to the program. The 2000 Olympic track cycling program includes four new events for a total of 12 events - 8 for men and 4 for women.

Australia was first represented in cycling events at the Olympic Games in Antwerp in 1920. Gerald Halpin and Jack King both took part in the 1000m scratch sprint.

Australia won its first cycling medal in 1928 at Amsterdam when Edgar 'Dunc' Gray took the bronze in the 1000m time trial, an event in which he had never before competed. Gray went on to take gold in world-record time in the 1000m time trial at the 1932 Los Angeles Games.

Histoire du cyclisme sur piste

La première course de cyclisme dont nous ayons gardé trace s'est déroulée à Paris en 1868. Les trois disciplines actuelles doivent leur évolution principalement aux progrès technologiques dont le vélo a bénéficié.

Les Etats-Unis et l'Angleterre jouèrent un rôle prépondérant dans le développement du cyclisme et, dans un premier temps, régnèrent sur le sport. Toutefois, ce dernier jouit d'une popularité croissante, particulièrement en Europe, et le succès du cyclisme sur piste est à présent mieux partagé dans le monde entier.

La première course féminine au monde aurait pris place en 1888 à Ashfield, dans la banlieue de Sydney.

Le cyclisme sur piste de nos jours

Dans un sport où chaque centième de seconde compte, résistance au vent et aérodynamisme optimal sont déterminants. De nos jours, pour améliorer leurs records, les coureurs sur piste portent des combinaisons faites d'une matière proche du polyester, ainsi que des casques aérodynamiques. Les vélos utilisés pour les épreuves sur piste disposent d'un développement unique, choisi en fonction de l'épreuve et du style du coureur, et ne comportent pas de freins. Les différentes épreuves sur piste requièrent un tel niveau technique et stratégique que les coureurs sont souvent amenés à se spécialiser dans les disciplines soit de vitesse, soit d'endurance.

Le cyclisme sur piste aux Jeux Olympiques

Le cyclisme sur piste est une discipline olympique depuis Athènes, en 1896, où une course de vitesse sur un tour, une course de 2 000 m, une course de 10 000 m et une autre de 12 heures figuraient au programme. La première épreuve féminine de cyclisme sur piste se déroula aux Jeux Olympiques de Séoul en 1988. Quant au programme de cyclisme sur piste des Jeux de Sydney 2000, il comprenait douze épreuves (huit épreuves masculines et quatre épreuves féminines), dont quatre étaient nouvelles.

La première participation olympique de l'Australie en cyclisme sur piste remonte à 1920, à Anvers. Gerald Halpin et Jack King ont tous deux participé au 1 000 m.

L'Australie a remporté sa première médaille de cyclisme sur piste en 1928 à Amsterdam, lorsque Edgar « Dunc Gray » décrocha le bronze au 1 000 m contre-la-montre, épreuve à laquelle il participait pour la première fois. Par la suite, Gray remporta la médaille d'or au 1 000 m contre-la-montre lors des Jeux de Los Angeles, en 1932, établissant ainsi un nouveau record du monde.

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La Fédération Australienne de Cyclisme (*Cycling Australia*) est l'organisme principal chargé du cyclisme sur route et sur piste, ainsi que du VTT en Australie.



The Olympic cycling competition will consist of the disciplines of track, road and mountain bike. Competition in cycling will take place over 15 days from 16 September (Day 1) to 30 September (Day 15), of which 22, 28 and 29 September are designated as rest days. The track events will run from 16 September (Day 1) to 21 September (Day 6).

The track competition will be at the Dunc Gray Velodrome, Bankstown.

The maximum number of athletes who may compete in the Olympic cycling competition is 480, with a maximum of 358 men and 122 women.

Competition Format

There will be 188 riders in the track events - 153 men and 35 women.

MEN

1km Time Trial

Cyclists will race one at a time against the clock. After four laps (1km) each rider's time is ranked with all others to determine final standings.

Sprint

All riders will complete a 200m time trial to determine the fastest 18 riders who will qualify for the first round. From the quarterfinals, two-up matches over two heats (a third deciding heat, if necessary) will be held. Quarterfinal winners contest semifinals. Quarterfinal losers ride a four-up round for places 5 - 8. Other losers ride for places 9 - 12.

Individual Pursuit

The four fastest riders qualify from the qualifying heats. Two cyclists compete in a 4km pursuit. The riders start on opposite sides of the track. The winner is determined by either catching the other rider or recording the fastest time.

Team Pursuit

Two teams of four compete against each other in a 4km race starting on each side of the track. There are two ways to win, the third rider of one team catches the third rider of the other team or by the timing of the fastest team which is judged by the front tyre of the third rider of the team to cross the line.

Points Race



Riders cover 40km. To win, a rider must accumulate the most points in the sprints, which occur every 10 laps, or lap the field. Sprint points are awarded as follows: five points for first, three points for second, two points for third and one point for fourth. Double points are awarded for the final sprint. The race is determined on distance together with accrued points.

Madison

Teams cover a distance of 60km. To win, a team must accumulate the most points in the sprints which occur every 20 laps, or lap the field. Sprint points are awarded as follows: five points for first, three points for second, two points for third and one point for fourth. Double points are awarded for the final sprint. The race is determined on distance covered, together with accrued points.

Keirin

Riders compete in a sprint after completing a number of laps behind a pacer. There are 20 riders in three heats of six to seven riders with 12 riders qualifying for the second round and six for the final. The pacer starts at 25km/h, increases to 45km/h and leaves the track with 2 laps to go.

Olympic Sprint

Run over three laps by teams of three riders, each of whom leads for one lap. First qualifying round determines the eight best teams. Second round selects the best four among the eight qualified teams. The teams with the best two times ride for the gold medal and the other two teams ride for the bronze medal.

WOMEN

500m Time Trial

Cyclists will race one at a time against the clock. For women, after two laps (500m) each rider's time is ranked with all others to determine final standings.

Sprint

All riders will complete a 200m time trial to determine the fastest 12 riders who will qualify for the first round. From the quarterfinals, two-up matches over two heats (a third deciding heat, if necessary) will be held. Quarterfinal winners contest semifinals. Quarterfinal losers ride a four-up round for places 5 - 8. Other losers ride for places 9 - 12.

Individual Pursuit

The four fastest riders qualify from the qualifying heats. Two cyclists compete in a 3km pursuit. Riders start on opposite sides of the track. The winner is determined by either catching the other rider or recording the fastest time.



Points Race

Riders cover 25km. To win, a rider must accumulate the most points in the sprints, which occur every 10 laps, or lap the field. Sprint points are awarded as follows: five points for first, three points for second, two points for third and one point for fourth. Double points are awarded for the final sprint. The race is determined on distance together with accrued points.

RULES OF TRACK CYCLING

The cycling competition at the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games will be held in accordance with the Olympic Charter and the *UCI Constitution and Rules* which are in force at the time of the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games.

Pursuant to the Olympic Charter, the UCI assumes the responsibility for the technical control and direction of its sport at the Olympic Games.



Les compétitions olympiques de cyclisme comprendront les disciplines suivantes : cyclisme sur piste, VTT et cyclisme sur route. Elles se dérouleront sur 15 jours, du 16 au 30 septembre 2000 (jours 1 à 15). Les 22, 28 et 29 septembre 2000 seront des jours de repos. Les épreuves sur piste se dérouleront du 16 au 21 septembre 2000 (jours 1 à 6) et les épreuves de VTT se tiendront les 23 et 24 septembre (jours 8 et 9). Quant aux épreuves sur route, elles auront lieu du 25 au 30 septembre (jours 10 à 15). La journée du 25 sera réservée à l'entraînement. Les 28 et 29 septembre seront des jours de repos.

Les épreuves sur piste se disputeront au Vélodrome Dunc Gray, à Bankstown, et celles de VTT sur le parcours de *Fairfield City Farm*, à Abbotsbury. Les épreuves sur route auront lieu aux Parcs du centenaire, avec *Moore Park* comme point de départ et d'arrivée. Le parcours traversera les Parcs du centenaire et *Bronte Beach*.

Le nombre total de cyclistes pouvant participer aux compétitions sera limité à 480 (358 hommes et 122 femmes).

FORMAT DES COMPETITIONS

Les coureurs participant aux épreuves sur piste seront au nombre de 188 (153 hommes et 35 femmes).

HOMMES

1 km contre la montre

Dans cette épreuve, les cyclistes partiront un par un et effectueront quatre tours de piste (soit 1 km). Un classement général sera ensuite établi d'après le temps de chaque coureur.

Vitesse individuelle

Un 200 m contre la montre déterminera les 18 coureurs les plus rapides. A partir des quarts de finale, les coureurs, par paires, disputeront un sprint dans deux manches et une belle éventuelle. Les vainqueurs des quarts de finale se qualifieront pour les demi-finales. Les quatre cyclistes qui se seront inclinés en quarts de finale



disputeront un sprint tous ensemble pour décider du classement de la 5^e à la 8^e place. Les dix coureurs non qualifiés pour les quarts de finale disputeront également une course afin d'établir le classement de la 9^e à la 12^e place et de la 13^e à la 18^e place.

Poursuite individuelle

Des séries de qualification permettront de désigner les quatre meilleurs coureurs. Les cyclistes courront un contre un et effectueront une poursuite sur 4 km. Les concurrents prendront le départ en deux points diamétralement opposés de la piste et pourront remporter la victoire soit en rejoignant l'autre coureur, soit en enregistrant le meilleur temps.

Poursuite par équipes

Deux équipes de quatre cyclistes seront opposées au cours d'une poursuite sur 4 km. Les équipes prendront le départ en deux points diamétralement opposés de la piste et pourront gagner de deux façons : en réalisant le meilleur temps ou lorsque le troisième coureur d'une équipe rattrape le troisième coureur de l'autre. Le temps retenu sera celui du troisième coureur et sera enregistré lorsque sa roue avant franchira la ligne d'arrivée.

Course aux points

La course aux points est une épreuve où les concurrents doivent couvrir une distance de 40 km. Le gagnant sera le concurrent qui aura accumulé le plus de points au cours des sprints intermédiaires qui se disputeront tous les dix tours de piste, ou qui prendra un tour d'avance sur le peloton. Les points seront attribués comme suit : cinq points pour le premier cycliste, trois pour le deuxième, deux pour le troisième et un pour le quatrième. Le dernier tour de piste comptera double. Le classement sera établi aux points et selon la distance parcourue.

Américaine

Les concurrents devront parcourir une distance de 60 km. L'équipe gagnante sera celle qui aura accumulé le plus de points au cours des sprints qui se disputeront tous les vingt tours de piste. Les points seront attribués comme suit : cinq points pour le premier coureur, trois pour le deuxième, deux pour le troisième et un pour le quatrième. Le classement sera établi selon le même principe que pour la course aux points.

Keirin

Le Keirin est une épreuve dans laquelle les coureurs disputent un sprint après avoir effectué un certain nombre de tours de piste en peloton, derrière un meneur de train. Les 21 partants, répartis en groupes de six ou sept, disputeront la première manche. Les douze meilleurs se qualifieront pour la deuxième manche, puis les six meilleurs d'entre eux pour la finale. Le meneur commencera à entraîner le peloton à 25 km/h, accélérera progressivement jusqu'à 45 km/h et quittera la piste lorsque les coureurs seront à deux tours et demi de l'arrivée.



Vitesse Olympique

La vitesse olympique est une épreuve sur trois tours de piste, opposant des équipes de trois coureurs. Chaque cycliste doit mener pendant un tour. La première série de qualification désignera les huit meilleures équipes et la deuxième déterminera les quatre meilleures d'entre elles. Les équipes qui auront réalisé les deux meilleurs temps s'affronteront pour la médaille d'or et les deux autres disputeront la course pour la médaille de bronze.

FEMMES

500 m contre la montre

Les cyclistes partiront une à une. A l'issue de deux tours de piste (soit 500 m), le temps effectué par chaque concurrente sera comparé à ceux de toutes les autres afin d'établir le classement général.

Vitesse individuelle

Un 200 m contre la montre déterminera les 12 concurrentes les plus rapides. A partir des quarts de finale, les concurrentes, par paires, disputeront un sprint dans deux manches et une belle éventuelle. Les vainqueurs des quarts de finale se qualifieront pour les demi-finales. Les quatre cyclistes qui se seront inclinées en quarts de finale disputeront un sprint toutes ensemble pour décider du classement de la 5^e à la 8^e place. Les dix concurrentes non qualifiées pour les quarts de finale disputeront une course afin d'établir le classement de la 9^e à la 12^e place.

Poursuite individuelle

Les quatre meilleures concurrentes à l'issue des séries de qualification participeront à cette épreuve. Deux cyclistes seront opposées au cours d'une poursuite sur 3 km. Les concurrentes prendront le départ en deux points diamétralement opposés de la piste et pourront remporter la victoire soit en rejoignant l'autre coureuse, soit en enregistrant le meilleur temps.

Course aux points

Les concurrentes devront couvrir une distance de 25 km. La gagnante sera la concurrente qui aura accumulé le plus de points au cours des sprints intermédiaires (tous les dix tours de piste), ou qui aura pris un tour d'avance sur le peloton. Les points seront attribués ainsi : cinq points pour la première, trois pour la deuxième, deux pour la troisième et un pour la quatrième. Les points du dernier tour de piste compteront double. Le classement sera établi aux points et d'après la distance parcourue.

REGLEMENT DES COMPETITIONS

Les compétitions de cyclisme se dérouleront conformément au règlement et aux statuts de l'UCI et à la Charte olympique en vigueur au moment des Jeux Olympiques de Sydney 2000. En vertu de la Charte olympique, l'UCI assume la responsabilité du contrôle et de la direction technique du cyclisme aux Jeux Olympiques.
